Results of the CARDS 2004 Adult Education Project

The final results of the highly successful CARDS 2004 Adult Education Project were presented in mid-April. The employees of the Agency stressed as one of their greatest achievements the establishment of a database that will consolidate the data on adult education institutions and their programs at the national level. In Croatia only 2,1 percent of population from 25 to 60 is involved in some kind of adult Education, lower percentages from EU 27 has only Greece, Bulgaria and Romania. The Head of the Delegation of European Commission to the Republic of Croatia, Vincent Degert, noted that the CARDS 2004 project was designed to support the development of a modern and flexible education system that will keep step with the demands of the European labour market and the principle of life-long learning.
